1. **Call to Order**- Bill calls the meeting to order at 7:00 pm
2. **Approval of minutes from the Annual Town Meeting on April 21, 2015** – Rosemary makes the correction of Town Board Supervisor’s salary amount from \$3500 to \$3000. Pat makes the motion to approve the minutes. Anthony Jones seconds the motion. No nays, motion carried
3. **Reports of Town Officers** – The county is working on the pot holes as they are in the area. Pat and Jackie explains about the Just Fix It campaign. This is a collaborative effort to help get the message to the state to achieve more funding to fix the roads. Bill discusses the biennial Town Picnic.
 - Lynn Beckford would like to see the Fix It campaign information on the website.
 - Due to weather Road review has been rescheduled to April 23 beginning at 8am
4. **2015 Annual Financial Report (Rosemary Mugan, Treasurer)** – Rosemary gives the overview of the financial report for 2015.
5. **Matters authorized by Section 60.10 Wisconsin Statutes**
 - Joyce Nanz speaks about a letter going around trying to restrict the ability for private shooting on personal property.
 - Tim Meredith discusses his shooting rights on his private property
 - Jackie Veldman explains what is all authorized under Section 60.10 Wisconsin Statutes
 - Chip Beckford explains if there is a change to an existing ordinance that there are procedures that need to be followed including holding public hearings. Game farms are regulated with the state. If there are trespassing issues it is a sheriff’s concern, not a Town Board issue.
 - Deputy Pringle explains the Sheriff Department’s views of recreation shooting. Law enforcement will become involved if there is irresponsible shooting. If the town wants to have an ordinance, then the town would need to contract with the Sheriff’s Department to enforce the ordinance.
 - Bob Rementer explains that the Town Board made it clear to the resident who was requesting a gun discharge ordinance that the town has no intention of making an ordinance for discharging firearms.
6. **Set date and time for the 2017 Annual Town Meeting (Suggest Statutory 3rd Tuesday in April – April 18, 2017)** - Chip Beckford makes the motion to hold the 2017 Annual Town Meeting on April 18, 2017 @ 7pm. Kristin Ringwell seconds the motion. No nays, motion carried.
7. **Appoint Audit Committee** - Chip Beckford and Eva Lehman volunteer to complete the 2016 audit.
8. **Swearing in New Officer** - Linnae swears in the new Town Board supervisors.
 - Chip Beckford thanks Bob Rementer for his time serving the town
 - Lou Jaeger would like to see more residents attend the meeting
9. **Adjournment** - Pat makes the motion to adjourn the meeting. Jackie seconds the motion. No nays, motion carried. Meeting is adjourned at 7:34 pm
