1. **Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance:** Dave called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The existing property is AG1 and the proposed is AG3. Existing use on existing land is: abandoned farm building site/pasture and the proposed use will be 1 (20 acre) parcel, with the same outbuildings, the use in accordance to Ag3. The existing property is Ag1 and the proposed is R2. Current existing land use: Wood lands and crop land, the proposed use will be 1 (15 acre) parcel with use in accordance to R2.
